


WRANGLER NFR RECORDS AND HISTORY

About the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo

The Wrangler National Finals Rodeo is the season-ending championship event for the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association and is widely acknowledged to be the world's premier rodeo. Held in December of each year at the Thomas & Mack Center in Las Vegas, the Wrangler NFR is ProRodeo's richest and most prestigious rodeo, and it showcases the very best cowboys, barrel racers and live-stock in the world.

The top 15 contestants in bareback riding, steer wrestling, team roping, saddle bronc riding, tie-down roping, barrel racing and bull riding – based on money won during the regular season and the Justin Boots Playoffs and Championships – qualify to compete at the Wrangler NFR. At the conclusion of the Wrangler NFR, the sport's world champions are determined based on total season earnings – what they won during the regular season and Justin Boots Playoffs and Championships (before the Wrangler NFR) *and* what they win during the Wrangler NFR itself.

The Wrangler NFR consists of 10 rounds on 10 consecutive nights. Cowboys and barrel racers earn money by placing first through sixth in any round, and more money by placing first through eighth in the average (cumulative times or points earned during the 10 rounds).

The 2008 Wrangler NFR was the 50th such event, and many special events honored the golden anniversary, including the ProRodeo Hall of Fame's Gold Buckle Gala at the South Point Hotel, Casino and Spa. ProRodeo Hall of Famer Larry Mahan rode a horse named Hollywood right into the ballroom. The Gala raised \$50,000 for the Hall of Fame, and the U.S. Smokeless Tobacco Company donated another \$25,000 on the spot.

Like most local rodeos, the 2008 Wrangler NFR also showcased rodeo's community spirit and Western heritage. Many cowboys participated in the Exceptional Rodeo for special needs kids; Wrangler (the title sponsor of the NFR) donated \$210,000 to the Gunnison, Colo., rodeo committee's breast cancer fundraising efforts during Tough Enough to Wear Pink Night; the 21st Annual ProRodeo League of Women's luncheon and fashion show raised \$80,000 for the Justin Cowboy Crisis Fund; Miss Rodeo America 2009 Maegan Ridley was selected and crowned; and Memorial Night honored 15 NFR luminaries who passed away during the previous year.

The Wrangler NFR had a prize purse of \$5.6 million in 2008, with an additional \$1.7 million paid to participating stock contractors. About 173,000 people attended the live performances, and many more saw it on TV – each round of the event was televised on ESPN2 or ESPN Classic, including six live broadcasts. There was plenty of excitement to keep everyone in their seats, whether at home or in the Thomas & Mack Center, as eight records were broken – four for single-season earnings – and Trevor Brazile became the first \$3 million all-around cowboy.
