What is Xtreme Bulls?

Xtreme Bulls, presented by B&W Trailer Hitches, showcases the PRCA's top bull riders and some of the ranked bulls the world has to offer. Xtreme Bulls events include a 10-stop Xtreme Bulls Tour that is managed, licensed and marketed by Winnercomm Sports of Tulsa, Okla., and televised on ESPN Classic.

The pool of bull riders for the Tour includes the top cowboys from the PRCA World Standings as well as contestants who advance through Xtreme Bulls qualifying events.

In Xtreme Bulls events, every contestant competes in the first round, with the top performers advancing to the final round. The winner of the two-head average after the final round wins that stop's title. Money won on the Xtreme Bulls Tour counts toward the PRCA World Standings, which determine the qualifiers for the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas.

In 2008, Chance Smart of Philadelphia, Miss., took home the Xtreme Bulls championship after earning \$72,788 during the 10-venue Tour. Highlights of the 2008 Xtreme Bulls Tour included a pair of big paydayes for Smart in San Antonio, Texas, and the finale in Indianapolis, Ind., and a pair of wins by 2007 World Champion Wesley Silcox, in Laughlin, Nev., and San Antonio, Texas. It was the second consecutive year for Silcox to have multiple Tour wins, something never before accomplished.
